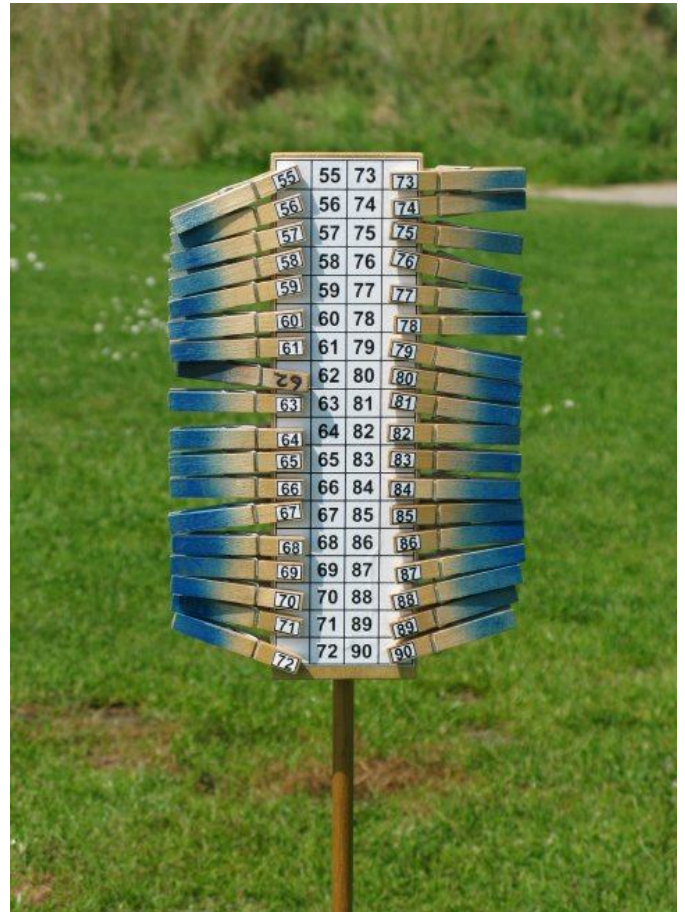


A pegboard is required to be used by any club member when flying a radio controlled model at the club field at meggies burn.

The photo to the right shows a common board in use which is simple to make and use, for an inexpensive outlay

Remember the saying
“no pegboard - no flying”



The following dimensions are a guide only

- 11” x 3” piece of light ply for the main body.
- 36” of dowel for the rod.
- 1 ¼” x 1 ¼” hardwood blocks drilled in the centre to the same diameter as the dowel
- 36 wooden pegs for the frequencies.

Glue the blocks and dowel to rear as shown.

Use clear varnish on the board and lightly sand when dry (this helps weatherproof and gives better adhesion for stickers)

Apply stickers.
